PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE



A NEW YEAR'S RESOLUTION FOR ST. JOSEPH'S SCHOOL

Happy New Year, Everyone! And Merry Christmas too!

Yes, in Catholic School the significance of Christmas is just too great to confine to just one day. Today is the 12th Day of Christmas. Today (and Sunday) we celebrate the Feast of the Epiphany and remember the Magi coming to visit the Baby Jesus. This story comes to us from the Gospel of Matthew, which was written for a Jewish Community. It tells that Gentiles, Non-Jews, were the first to recognize Jesus as Messiah. As Non-Jews were

outsiders in that community, it illustrates how God reaches out to those on the margins, those who are most in need of love. Like the gifts from the Wise Men, I received many gifts and cards of appreciation at Christmas. Thank you to all of you! I kept them until Christmas morning and opened them then. They were much appreciated, but really the best gift you give all of us is the opportunity to work with your children. It gives us a life full of meaning.

As it is the New Year, it is time to make a resolution. This year, now that most COVID restrictions are lifted, it is time to once again be faithful to the uniform code. This code has been revised and follows this message for your easy reference.

As with the implementation of everything new, there will be many questions and a bit of a learning curve to overcome. Next week, my message will be a Q & A. Please send your questions in and I will answer them. A few early clarifications are as follows:

- The Uniform Code has been slightly revised. Please do not refer to the one on-line. Please use the attached version here.
- Everyone is allowed to make mistakes as we implement the Revised Code. If you make mistakes, a Uniform Infraction is just a learning tool.
- If you need time to comply with a regulation, please write on the uniform infraction return what you need and when you can meet the requirements. (E.g., I just bought new shoes and they are not all black. Can my son wear them out first and I'll buy all black shoes next time?)
- Students need separate outdoor shoes. If you choose all black runners for indoor shoes, these can double as gym shoes.
- The Hair band statement was awkwardly worded. Hair bands should be white, black, grey or burgundy.

No-one should be overly anxious about returning to uniform compliance. As long as we are aware of what we need to do, and have a plan to do it, we are on the path to a successful completion of a New Year's Resolution!

Winter Uniform/ Full-Dress Uniform	
Thanksgiving Day until Spring Break, Girls'	School Masses and Formal Assemblies Boys'
K-3 gray tunic or gray skort (no shorter than 2 inches above the knee) or girls' gray dress pants 4-7 gray kilt or gray skort or girls' gray dress pants Skirts and skorts may not be shorter than 2 inches above the knee	Plain gray dress pants. Polyester/viscose blend recommended.
Plain white cotton blouse, with pointed collar, buttons in the front. Long or short sleeves. No stand-up collars, frills lace or embroidery. No coloured or patterned t-shirts under blouses.	Plain white long-sleeved or short-sleeved dress shirt. No coloured or patterned t-shirts under shirts.
Gray and burgundy single crested tie.	Gray and burgundy single crested tie.
Burgundy cardigan, pull-over or vest. School sweater must be worn at the beginning of each day.	Burgundy cardigan, pull-over or vest. School sweater must be worn at the beginning of each day.
Plain black dress shoes or all black including soles runners free of coloured logos or stitching. Pump style shoes, boots or heels higher than ½ inch are not allowed.	Plain black dress shoes or all black (including soles) runners free of coloured logos or stitching. No boots.
Gray knee-high socks or tights. No frills or lace on socks or tights.	Gray or black socks.
An optional hair band in gray, burgundy, white or black may be worn.	

Haircuts must be neat and compliment the school uniform – no extreme haircuts or styles, including razor cut or dyed designs. Hair dyeing or bleaching is not allowed. Make-up and nail polish are not permitted. One or two small stud or sleeper earrings are permitted. Additional jewellry is not permitted unless approved by the principal.

Exceptions to the uniform code (e.g. discreet jewelry of a religious or cultural nature) may be approved by the principal on a case-by-case basis for religious, cultural or health reasons.

Students wearing Hijab must choose colours of gray, white, burgundy or black.




