The Catholic Schools Week Mass on Sunday. This event highlighted the knowledge and skill of our students performing the work of liturgy at the St. Joseph's the Worker 10:00 a.m. Mass. The altar servers were skilled, reverent, and supported Father Alfie in the

sanctuary. The readers who proclaimed scripture, the psalm, and read the prayers of the faithful, had obviously practiced at home and were expressive and audible. The choir was talented, enthusiastic, and led us in song with energy and grace. Thank you to the parents who made the commitment to come to this mass and work at home with their children in preparation. Thank you also, to the teachers who served as eucharistic ministers. Many other teachers also attended even though they might usually attend church elsewhere. A special thank you goes out to Father Alfie, our pastor and chaplain, who always encourages the entire school community on the path of faith.

On Monday, the entire student body participated in our annual Face to Face Retreat. Wednesday, the Grade Sixes highlighted our theme of Truth, Healing and Reconciliation with a prayer at the beginning of assembly and the whole school joined the choir in the performance of "The Wellerman" – how fun!

On Thursday, we had a Teacher vs. Student Volleyball Game. What a great way to have fun with the kids. I was especially impressed with the skill of the players of our boys' volleyball team whom I played against. Liam and Kia, you are a force to be reckoned with! 
- 3. Click on the "Register" tab and fill in the registration form to create an account. All fields are required on the parent registration form to create an account.






