PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE



ST. JOSEPH'S PARKING LOT 101

This week I would like to extend a warm welcome to all the new families who have joined our school community! Welcome! We hope you are finding a warm reception and new second family with us.

New families may be realizing that one of the major challenges facing our school is negotiating the parking lot. At the beginning of the year, it is very helpful to share with our new families some of the protocols we have developed to ease the challenge and the frustrations of picking up and dropping off the children. For the rest of us, it also provides a good review of our practices.

Please, everyone, have a look at the parking guide following the principal's message and review the practices to help us all pick up and drop off children in the most efficient way possible.

Also, this week, I would like to highlight the work of the Grade Fours, who harvested the produce of our Masithuthu Potato Garden. These enthusiastic students had a blast Wednesday morning digging in the dirt and harvesting about 1500 lbs of potatoes which will be stored in Father Alfie's garage and used as the foundational ingredient to create the soup which we serve to the needy at St. Andrew's Cathedral Soup Kitchen.

We even had a surprise visit from some Saanich Firefighters who were responding to a false alarm fire and, having confirmed there was no emergency, just jumped in and helped us out.

What a blessing it is to work in a school that puts faith into action and to watch children joyfully engaged in serving the needy. Bishop Gary has expressed their work so eloquently:

This potato project is so crucial and is at the heart of authentic Catholic education, It is foundational for what Pope Francis calls "A Global Education Compact. "It puts the children, parents, and staff in touch with the earth and the millions of people who need this "Garden of Creation" to live well.

Thank you, Grade Fours, Mrs. Fallow, Mrs. Katz, Mrs. Amos Miss Tapin, Father Alfie, Past Teacher, Farmer Jamie Zwicker and Saanich Firefighters Ashmead and Hennessy. You truly have accomplished an amazing good work and engaging social justice project.




Are you a student in grade 1-7and enjoy singing, acting, or dancing? Or how about all three?!


