#### ST. JOSEPH'S CELEBRATES SUCCESSFUL REPORT CARD PILOT



The results of the survey are in! You may remember that the Ministry of Education and Childcare revised the BC Curriculum many years ago and has finally changed the way we report student progress to reflect the changes made to our goals and methods of instruction.

St. Joseph's Staff took the initiative this year to create a report card that would best convey information about where a child is in relation to proficiency and ways to move toward that goal. Here are the results:

Question 1: 145 responses to "How well does this report card meet your needs for learning about your child's progress?"

30% Very Well

28% Well

23% Acceptable

12% Not bad

6% poorly

The acceptable to very well positive response is 82%

The not bad to poorly negative response is 18%

Question 2: 138 responses (some new parents did not answer this question) to "How well does this report card compare to the previous one in reporting your child's progress?"

46% Better

33% Same

21% Worse

The same or better positive response is 79%

The worse negative response is 21%

Our next step is to invite St. Patrick's School and St. Andrew's Grade 8 and 9 to join us in phase two of the pilot. Thank you to everyone who participated and congratulations to the Cerna Family who won the \$50.00 draw for a gift certificate to the family activity of their choice.

Two other pieces of information you need for next week are:

- We are planting potatoes on Monday. Students should wear their regular uniform for this day but will wear outdoor shoes for the planting.
- Spraying for Spongy Moths is scheduled Thursday, May 16 before 7:30 a.m. We will keep the students in the school until 8:30 a.m. as suggested by the Ministry of Forests.
