Summer 2024 Call for Student Gardeners

The Masithuthu Garden is our St Joseph's School and Parish social justice venture where potatoes are planted in the spring by students, cared for by parishioners, parent and student volunteers over the summer, and harvested in the fall by the Gr. 4s. Potatoes are donated to the Soup Kitchen, the Social Concerns Office of the SVdP, and to the student-run Foodbanks at both Camosun College and UVic.



There is a lot of growth over the summer. Besides potatoes, we have found there's a lot of *other* green stuff that grows in our Masithuthu Garden: you guessed it - weeds!

If you are in grade 4 and above and would like to spend an hour or two per week doing some weeding with us, we would certainly appreciate your help and enjoy your company.

Though it may not be glamorous work, it's outside in the fresh air and sunshine. You may learn something about gardening – and perhaps discover some of your own hidden talents too. You will also be contributing your time to practically and genuinely help others in our community who need it.

At the end of the summer (and providing you have volunteered at least 3 times with us), we will provide you with a **Masithuthu Crew** t-shirt, and provide an ***awesome*** letter of reference – I promise! What a way for you to feel good about yourself, and even wow your parents and future employers!
